## US Utility-Scale Solar & Wind Capacity

Renewable energy sources, such as solar and wind, are projected to see the largest increase of proportional share of generating capacity through the end of 2020. Meanwhile, non-renewable sources, such as coal and nuclear, might experience a new decline up to 6.6% and 2.2% respectively.

## Renewable Energy

Current trends in renewable energy indicate that rapid expansion of renewable sources and the growing dominance over the energy industry will continue to trend throughout 2021. A report released by the U.S. Federal Energy Regulatory Commissions (FERC) showed proposed net growth in generating capacity of almost 150,000 MW, closing in on 70% of the total capacity.

Net generating capacity (additions less retirements) showed wind at 84k MW and solar at 48k MW, comprising 62.8% combined. The remainder was supplemented by hydropower at 11k MW, geothermal at 1k MW and biomass at 610 MW.

## Misae Solar Park

Misae Solar Park currently consists of two phases, covering more than 5,000 acres located outside of Childress, TX. Misae Solar is a joint venture between Dr. Miguel Oneto, Hector Rodriguez, Serafin Seoane, & Pablo de Rosas. The land for this project was procured by Dirk van Reenen of USA Land and Ranch, LLC, along with the negotiation for all mineral and executive rights for the property involved.
